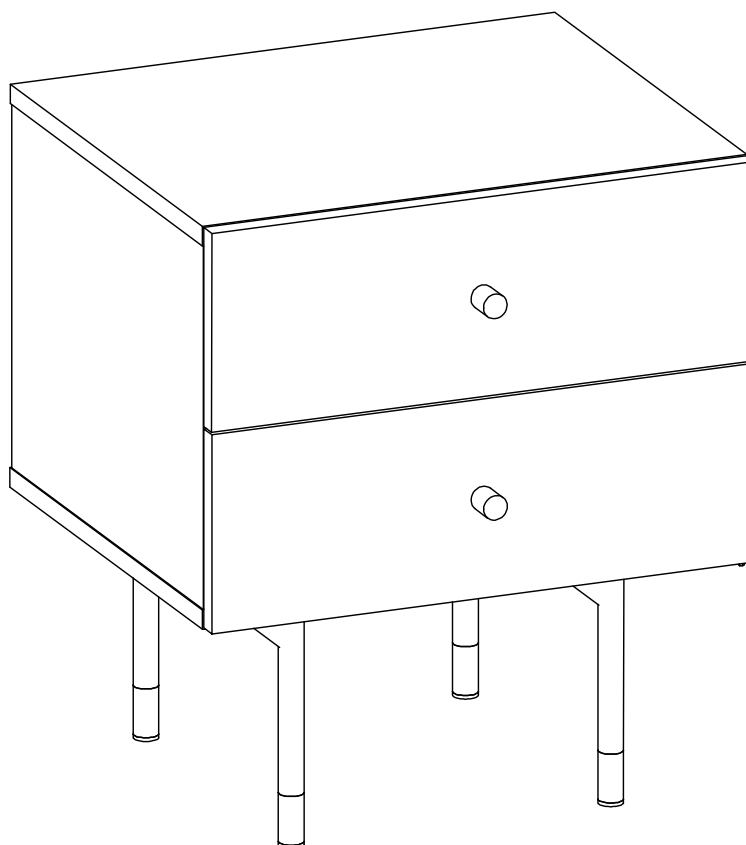

- Keep the assembly instruction

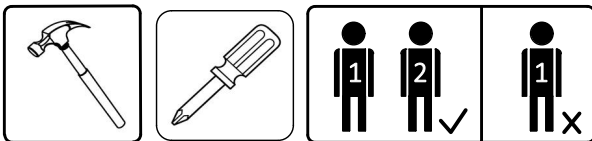
### Allocate time

# Safety and Care Advice

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## General care and maintenance

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Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

## Cleaning and care of lacquered surfaces

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Regular dusting with a dry cloth will keep your units clean.

Clean marks with a damp cloth.

Do not use abrasive cleaners.

Do not clean with products containing following:

Acetone (e.g. nail varnish remover). Ammonia (e.g. bleach) or Sodium hydroxide (e.g. Caustic soda, drain and oven cleaners).

To remove stubborn stain, wipe over with damp cloth and washing up liquid.

In the event of accidental contact with aggressive cleaners, rinse thoroughly with water. Use place mats to protect the surface from moisture and heat.
